A Symposium for English Graduate Students . . . SEGue is a gathering of MA students, students beginning Doctoral programs, their peers, and other interested people for the purpose of showcasing the best work of English Graduate students; connecting with other graduate students and faculty; and preparing for MA students' next professional segue, be that further study or a profession.

The College at Brockport's third annual **SEGue** conference, to be held on April 29th, 2017, invites proposals from graduate students that investigate any topic related to the study of literature. Interested graduate students should submit an abstract of approximately 300 words by no later than **March 17, 2017**. (*Submissions open January 3, 2017.*)

THE SEGUE COMMITTEE INVITES TWO TYPES OF PROPOSALS:

- A 15-20 minute paper that investigates the study of literature on any topic.
- Original creative works of fiction, nonfiction, poetry and/or a hybrid of any of these genres. Creative works may approach the symposium topic in a direct, oblique or otherwise unconventional manner.
