REQUIREMENTS FOR LISTING ON DEAN'S LIST

BE IT RESOLVED THAT requirements for listing on Dean's List be altered as follows:

Semester Dean's List: Minimum of 12 indexable hours, no failing grades for the semester, 3.25 semester GPA.

Cumulative Dean's List: Minimum of 12 indexable hours and 2 semesters at Brockport, 3.25 cumulative GPA.

This change to take place as soon as possible, consistent with any obligations that may exist towards students already matriculated at Brockport.
