PROPOSED ACADEMIC CALENDAR - 1978-79

The following calendar has been discussed by the Long Range Planning Committee and is recommended to the Senate for adoption. In order to provide greater flexibility in planning, the committee is recommending the establishment of a period of ten weeks in summer of 1978 for summer instruction without at this time defining the detailed schedule within that period. A proposal for the summer schedule for 1978 will be presented in the Fall of 1977 when enrollment data for summer 1977 have been reviewed.
