Resolution on Treatment of Visitors to the Campus

- WHEREAS: Visitors to the campus are often unfamiliar with the location of buildings and offices;
- WHEREAS: Visitors to the campus are often seeking information about College services/programs;
- WHEREAS: Visitors to the campus are often unfamiliar with College parking regulations; and
- WHEREAS: Visitors to the campus often patronize the Student Union snack bar

BE IT RESOLVED THAT: the President of the College direct the appropriate campus officials to:

- 1) erect accurate, visually effective, vandal-resistant map/directory boards at principal entry points;
- 2) establish a Visitor Information Center, such facility to be staffed seven days a week and to be adequately supplied with printed materials describing academic programs and College services;
- 3) designate an area adjacent to the above facility as a visitors-only parking lot; and
- 4) recommend to FSA that they utilize their funds to refurbish and redecorate the snack bar area in the Student Union.
