Resolution on Resource Allocation

- BE IT RESOLVED THAT the College President, or his designee provide adequate opportunities for the Faculty Senate to respond and react to any model or models to be used for resource allocation decisions prior to implementation and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all such proposed models or plans affecting resource allocation be referred by the Senate to the Permanent Subcommittee on Resource Allocation which shall, as part of its continuing charge, review, study and conduct such investigations as may be necessary to ensure that adequate opportunities are provided for members of the faculty and professional staff to respond and react to said plans, and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Subcommittee on Resource Allocation shall submit in a timely fashion to the Senate, through the Committee for Long-Range Planning, such recommendations and/or reports as may be warranted as a consequence of its activities.
