Resolution to Establish an Advisory Committee on Publications

Whereas publications of various types and for many purposes by the College are increasing at a rapid rate, and at an ever increasing cost, and

Whereas there is difficulty in coordinating these diverse activities or assessing their value to the College's varied programs, and

Whereas there is a present need to examine the efficiency, the cost-benefit value and quality of some of the present and proposed publications ventures in the light of the current and projected future fiscal situation of the College.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Administration, in consultation with the Faculty Senate, establish an Advisory Committee on Publications to assist in the coordination and the establishment of priorities for the publications program of the College.
