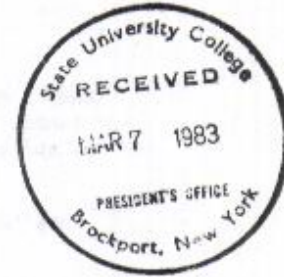

Undergraduate Student Policies

DISABILITY STATEMENT

1. The College shall publish a notice that a student with a handicapping condition who wishes to take a course should contact the Office of Handicapped Student Services before registration so that appropriate support services may be arranged.
2. To be read and distributed in writing the first week of each academic semester and summer session:

"I would appreciate hearing from anyone in this class who has a special need which may be the result of a disability. I am reasonably sure we can work out whatever arrangement is necessary, be it special seating, testing or other accommodation. See me after class, or during my office hours, as soon as possible."
