PEACE EDUCATION DAY

SUNDAY, APRIL 24, 1983

WHEREAS the advance of scientific knowledge and its technological application has made possible the development of nuclear weapons of previously unimaginable destructive power,

and

WHEREAS the use of these weapons in a full scale war places in jeopardy nothing less than human life on this planet,

and

WHEREAS the issue of arms control is now a matter of intense and widespread public discussion in this country,

and

WHEREAS it is the clear responsibility of colleges and universities and all concerned citizens in our society to address compelling issues of public policy,

and

WHEREAS both SUNY College at Brockport and the local community have focussed considerable attention on these issues during the academic year 1982-1983,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Faculty Senate of the State University of New York College at Brockport does endorse and support the initiative of the Brockport Student Government in developing a Peace Education Day program designed to foster greater understanding of nuclear disarmament possibilities and world peace issues and to provide opportunity for the students of this college and the citizens of this region to express their views on these most urgent matters.
