Naming of the Administration Building

- WHEREAS Dr. Gordon F. Allen served the College and University communities for over 23 years while rising through the academic ranks to full Professor, as chair of the Education and Psychology Department in 1955, as Dean of the College, and as Acting President, 1964-65; and
- WHEREAS Dr. Allen gave unselfishly of his time, talents, and energy to promote growth of the College at Brockport from a teacher training institution to a College of Arts and Sciences; and
- WHEREAS we the college faculty and administration wish to acknowledge and recognize Dr. Allen's outstanding contributions to the quality of education at the College at Brockport;
