The Health Science faculty unanimously presents the following resolution to the Faculty Senate:

RESOLUTION ON A
FACULTY SENATE STATEMENT

ON

"GLOBAL INTERDEPENDENCE AND CULTURAL DIVERSITY"

1. WHEREAS: The faculty of the SUNY College at Brockport has the responsibility and authority to determine the academic program of the college; and,
2. WHEREAS: The Faculty Senate is the formal representative body of the faculty on a college-wide level; and,
3. WHEREAS: The Faculty Senate did not initiate nor sponsor the President's Ad Hoc Committee on the Future of the College; and,
4. WHEREAS: The Faculty Senate has not formally adopted the Report of the President's Ad Hoc Committee; and,
5. WHEREAS: The Faculty Senate has recently adopted a revised College Mission Statement which contains a new reference to "...an understanding of global interdependence and cultural diversity...".
6. THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED THAT: The Faculty Senate establish its own ad hoc committee or similar unit for the purpose of creating a conceptual framework for the reference to "global interdependence and cultural diversity" in the revised Mission Statement; and
7. THAT: The Faculty Senate refer to this committee the Report of the President's Ad Hoc Committee and any proposals for implementation of the academic recommendations of that report; and,
8. THAT: The Faculty Senate direct its committee to involve faculty in all programs and departments of the college in considering the implications of the College Mission reference to "global interdependence and cultural diversity" for the specific academic programs, courses, and other academic activities of the college.
