Resolution to Appoint an Alternate SUNY Faculty Senator
to Complete the Last Year of the Term 1986-89

WHEREAS the election of Jayne Vogan to a three-year term as a SUNY Senator to commence in the Fall, 1988, will create a vacancy in the position of Alternate SUNY Senator for the last year of a three-year term that commenced in Fall, 1986,

and

WHEREAS a recent election for a full three-year term as Alternate SUNY Faculty Senator yielded only one interested candidate,

and

WHEREAS holding an all campus election to fill the one-year vacancy in the position of Alternate SUNY Faculty Senator appears to be redundant and an inefficient use of resources,

and
