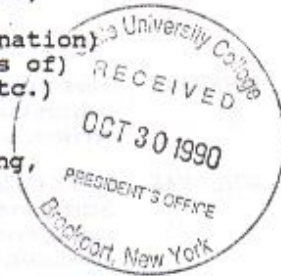

WHEREAS... It has become necessary to establish comprehensive fund raising, contribution, and gift acceptance policies that assist the College and potential donors to enhance campus programs, facilities and services, and

WHEREAS... SUNY College at Brockport endorsed private fund raising by the establishment of the State University College at Brockport Foundation Inc. in 1976, the only fund guidelines for fund raising have been the Policies of the SUNY Board of Trustees and Chapter 300 of the Faculty Handbook, and

WHEREAS... The Executive Director of College Development, at the request of the State University College at Brockport Foundation Inc., through the College President, was directed in 1987 to develop fund raising, contribution and gift acceptance policies, the research for these policies has been ongoing since 1987, and the policies herein are the results of that extensive research, therefore,

*BE IT
RESOLVED*... That the Faculty Senate of SUNY College at Brockport endorse, with the attached recommendations, the Fund Raising, Contribution, and Gift Acceptance Policies as submitted by the Executive Director of College Development.

Recommendations

1. A statement excluding all works in progress from the proposed monetary guidelines of the new policy be included. Existing scholarship programs and the like must be permitted to continue with their present dollar amounts, even though they may be less than what the new policy sets forth. Established scholarships and works will not be retroactively subjected to the minimums proposed by the new policy.

2. Naming of Building policies and procedures set forth will not be retroactively imposed upon existing buildings, nor would they negate previous recommendations for currently existing buildings.

3. That all language within the policy be consistent: I.E.: Fund Raising, Contribution and Acceptance Policies vs. Fundraising, Gift Acceptance Policies. State University College at Brockport Foundation, Inc. vs. Brockport College Foundation vs. Brockport Foundation.
