FOR STUDENTS WITH A HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA
1999-2000**

I. Regular Freshmen

1. Regents program, or a minimum of [~~16~~] 17 academic units, including the senior year
 - 4 English
 - 4 Social studies
 - [~~2~~] 3 College preparatory math
 - [~~2~~] 3 Science (one with lab)
 - [~~4~~] 3 Additional academic courses, which could include foreign language, math, science, English, social studies, fine arts, or technology education
2. Average of 80 or better or standing in top 1/2 of the graduating class
3. Recommended SAT of 1000 or ACT of 21

II. Transition Freshmen (Summer Program)

1. Regents program or minimum of [~~16~~] 17 academic units, including the senior year
 - 4 English
 - 4 Social studies
 - [~~2~~] 3 College preparatory math
 - [~~2~~] 3 Science (one with lab)
 - [~~4~~] 3 Additional academic courses, which could include foreign language, math, science, English, social studies, fine arts, or technology education
2. Average of 77 or better or standing in top 3/4 of the graduating class
3. Recommended SAT of 950 or ACT of 18

III. Excel

1. Regents program or minimum of [46] 17 academic units, including senior year
 - 4 English
 - 4 Social studies
 - [2] 3 College preparatory math
 - [2] 3 Science (one with lab)
 - [4] 3 Additional academic courses, which could include foreign language, math, science, English, social studies, fine arts, or technology education
2. Average of 76 or better or standing in top 3/4 of the graduating class
3. Recommended SAT of 1100 or ACT of [23] 24

IV. Exceptional Talent Freshmen To include students who have unique or outstanding qualities in such areas as athletics or the fine arts.

2. Average of 76 or better or standing in top 3/4 of the graduating class
3. Recommended SAT of 900 or ACT of 18

V. EOP Freshmen For students who do not meet the regular admission criteria, but who do meet income guidelines set by NYS. A successful pre-admission interview is required.

1. 14 Academic units, including a minimum one year of college preparatory math - Course I
2. Average of 74 or above
3. SAT or ACT Scores required

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
