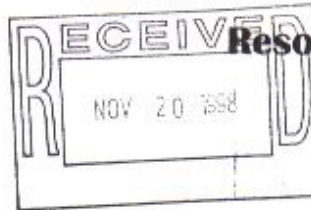

Resolution on Lampposts

Whereas the new red lampposts in the East Quadrangle/Hartwell Hall Mall are in keeping with the architectural design concept;

Whereas the lampposts are color coordinated with the area's bike racks, benches, trash receptacles and other fixtures;

Whereas the cost to repaint the posts alone would be \$16,100;

Whereas the posts would have to be repainted every five years to mask weathering effects, which could start within a year;

And whereas the existing factory-applied glazed paint is designed to last 25 years;

Be it resolved that the Faculty Senate of the State University of New York recommends to the College Administration that the lampposts remain as they are.
