There has been discussion on various changes related to the restructuring of the School of Arts and Performance including the phasing out of Interdisciplinary Arts as an academic department while retaining the Arts for Children major program.

As a part of this process, the School is looking carefully at the other programs currently offered under the auspices of IDA. Given the existing and projected resources in the School, neither the Art History minor nor the Arts Management minor can be adequately staffed now nor in the near future. I believe that in the best interest of students (and to insure truth in advertising), we should put these minors on hold until further assessment of the situation guarantees adequate resources.

Dr. Michael Fox recommended that I notify the Faculty Senate and suggested removing the minors from the catalog draft. Please note that we are committed to supporting the existing majors through their course work. And further, this is not to say that I will not work to restore these minors at some time in the future when faculty resources are sufficient to guarantee student success. I look forward to that day.
