The English Department has voted to change the requirements for admission to our graduate program (page 123 of the current catalog):

Replace the current 3:

3. Applicants for the Literature track must submit a sample of their expository writing. Applicants for the Creative Writing track must submit a sample of their creative writing.

This brings the procedure for the Literature track in line with those for Creative Writing and the (currently suspended) Rhetoric and Composition tracks. It also indicates the Department's concern for writing by all our graduate students.

This proposal was also submitted last year, but no response was received. We would like to implement this change in the next graduate catalog.
